

Classes begin in September and run through our May performance. Our dance year consists of <u>two</u> 15-week semesters: Fall (September - December) and Winter (January - May). Families are to register their dancers for the <u>same classes</u> at the beginning of each semester. (Specific registration dates will be e-mailed to all members on our mailing list). All tuition payments are to be made online using a credit card or PayPal. Families can choose to pay in full upon registration or have their tuition payment divided into four monthly payments. If the payment plan option is chosen, please be aware that each class will have its own separate payment plan and cannot be combined with other classes. TUITION INFO & FEES:

- All families must create an online account at www.PetitAllegroDance.com.
- Please subscribe to our mailing list for updates, events and registration dates.
- Always put your child on a wait list if the class you desired is full. Wait listed students will be added to the class in the order they were placed on the wait list. Parents will be notified if a space becomes available.
- · Classes need a minimum of five students in order to run.

- There is a \$25 non-refundable registration fee that is due per family at the beginning of each semester. This fee ensures your child a place in the dance class.
- Each studio class (unless otherwise specified) has a \$60 costume fee and is designed to be a one-year course and commitment. Classes that meet twice per week have one costume fee.
- In lieu of charging individual tickets for our annual spring recital, each family pays a \$60 RECITAL FEE which covers the rent of our performance facility and allows families to invite unlimited guests to the show.
- If families choose the 4 month payment plan, the monthly reoccurring payment will be charged on the same day each month that the class was first purchased. If the payment plan option is chosen, please be aware that each class will have its own separate payment plan and cannot be combined with other classes. Please email our office if your family has more than 4 payment plans to arrange.
- If weather conditions throughout the year cause more than two cancellations, makeup classes will be scheduled by the instructor.

- Any student with an outstanding tuition balance will not be permitted to perform in the recital.
- No adjustments or refunds will be made in tuition for absences.
- <u>Please note</u>: new students joining our program in January will have a \$25 rush fee for their recital costume and will likely require several private lessons to bring them up to speed on the class choreography.
- In the event that your child is no longer able or interested in attending their dance class mid-semester, it is the parent's responsibility to contact the studio at info@petitallegrodance.com to request their child be removed from the class. Tuition will not be reimbursed for missed classes that occurred before the removal request was submitted. Parents are strongly encouraged to speak to their child's instructor should they have any questions or concerns prior to dropping a class. We strive for open communication and will do everything possible to ensure that each student is correctly placed in a class and level where they are growing and successful. Please e-mail to set up a teacher meeting or phone call.
- Our first priority is our student's safety, therefore, if a student is more than 10 minutes late, they are NOT permitted to participate in class. By this point in time, they have missed the warm up and are AT RISK for sprains and/or pulled muscles. Students are expected to attend classes regularly. Students are permitted but not encouraged to miss up to three classes per semester. Upon a fourth absence, a make up private lesson is required. Parents are financially responsible for private make up lesson. Absences do not "roll over" each semester.
- Many of our classes only meet once per week, so we kindly ask that you make every effort to be on time for your child's drop off and pick up.
